## Simple Event Entry system still in use at Perstorp




Perstorp and its sister company Solvay Interox are major chemical companies operating from their site in Warrington.

They started using action management systems developed by Strategic Safety systems many years ago, and have a comprehensive system for reporting and analysing hazards, near misses and accidents. The Event Entry system is linked into the main system and enables anyone to quickly enter a record.

This picture shows the event entry screen. The type box enables the person to state whether it is a hazard, injury, etc.

Once entered, the person clicks the SEND button and an e-mail is sent to the H&S Co-ordinator.

The person can track what is happening as a result of submitting this report by being able to select the event number form the opening screen (not shown.)
