General statement of policy

Specific Arrangements

Legislation

Operations shall comply with appropriate legislation and guidance relating to this. Strategic Safety Systems shall maintain an up-to-date register of relevant legislation.

Specific site requirement

Strategic Safety Systems will comply with all specific requirements of clients with respect to the provisions in case of fire, the wearing of PPE and any other requirement. In the absence of any specific requirement, Strategic Safety Systems personnel will ensure that client personnel are aware of their presence and absence from site.

Strategic Safety Systems will not introduce any unsafe item onto a client site.

Transport

Where possible, travel shall be organised to minimise the number of journeys made by road vehicles. This shall include scheduling trips so that customers in the same area can be visited and the use of overnight stays instead of travel. Where rail transport is a viable alternative, then this shall be used in preference to road transport.

Notification

Where a Strategic Safety Systems employee notice items or practices which he, as a health and safety professional, considers to be unsafe, then he will bring it to the attention of his client contact. This will occur even if the prime reason for Strategic Safety Systems being on site is not related to health and safety.
